Gift Restrictions

Due to strict infection control precautions, we can only accept donations that are new in original packaging and recently purchased.

We Cannot Accept

- Used (including gently-used) toys and items
- Balloons, rubber balls, or rubber erasers (we are a latex free facility)
- Toys or stuffed animals exposed to smoke or other odors
- Collector items that have been stored over a significant time
- Gift-wrapped items

We Can Accept

- Dolls (Disney princesses, Barbie)
- Toy cars and trucks (Hot Wheels)
- Action figures (Star Wars, super heroes)
- Art supplies (coloring books, crayons, markers)
- Bluetooth speakers and headphones
- Sensory toys (light spinners, pop its)
- Legos (smaller sets)
- Gift cards (Amazon, Target, Walmart, Smith's)
- Items for teens (adult coloring books, advanced craft kits)
